With the arrival of autumn the Teton Photography Club swings into full gear with many photographic activities. You have already read about the Peer Mentor Group activities and our monthly public presentation for October, but there is much more coming.

First we are ramping up the TPCed programs for the fall. We have two Thursday evening classes and one Saturday morning workshop in the advanced planning stages. Topics were determined from the 2018 Member Needs Survey last fall and a vote by the Peer Mentor Group this summer. The classes will be "Macro Photography: Up close" and "Making your images POP in Lightroom." The half-day Saturday morning workshop will be "Advanced local
