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***If it's Wednesday, it's photography night in Jackson!***

Kicking off the month is our first informal [image critique / discussion](#) session on **Wednesday, January 2 at 6pm at JHREA**, 80 W Broadway, in the small conference room. These sessions are open to members only and are some of the best learning experiences available to all photographers from novices to professionals. We work through image critiques, both good and problem points, in a friendly, constructive manner and often do on-line editing with suggestions by the group for new ways to view the images. Attendees are asked to **bring 3-4 images** on a USB drive for discussion with the group. These can be processed raw images (preferably in DNG format) that can be edited or simple JPEGs for viewing and limited edits. Everyone learns while having fun in these sessions. The winter critiques will continue on Wednesdays in February and March.



On **Wednesday, January 16 at 6pm** at JHREA, 80 W Broadway, in the large conference room will feature a presentation from Bradley Boner who has been the Director of Visuals at the Jackson Hole News&Guide since 2004. His presentation will draw on insights from his 20-year career as a photojournalist, how photojournalism is unique from other fields of photography and the role it can play in a community, and how photo editors work with reporters and designers to tell stories..

A look forward to February's program: On **Wednesday, February 20** we'll be celebrating our ***Teton Masters: 5 years of great images and the stories behind them***. Michael Cohen will curate and host this special [event](#).

The third annual Yellowstone winter photo tour is January 31 - February 5. This event is fully booked and we look forward to seeing images from the participants at a future meeting.

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A note from the Chair:

We on the TPC Executive Committee are very excited about our new ability to deliver high-value photography content to our members. Our plans for 2019 are the most innovative since we began almost 6 years ago in 2013. We will be celebrating the end of our fifth anniversary year in [February](#) with a very special program. We are beginning our **Wednesday** photography nights and abandoning our traditional third Monday public presentations. First Wednesdays will be special critique sessions or educational events, second Wednesdays will be the Peer Mentor Program discussions, third Wednesday's will be our traditional public presentations open to the community, and the fourth Wednesdays will be for other educational or social events.

We are happy to announce that Executive Committee member, David Brookover, will be chairing our new [Community Advisory Board](#) to generate input from civic and business leaders in our community about how we can better serve our community.
