A Note From the President:

I am very excited to announce our biggest program event, ever. **Shoot Like A Girl—Women Wildlife Photographers**, will be our fifth full-day educational symposium and a major photographic event in the mountain west. It's a full day, on September 28, in

the Cook Auditorium of the National Museum of Wildlife Art and will feature renowned conservation photojournalist Morgan Heim as keynote speaker and five other outstanding western female wildlife photographers. The symposium is chaired by TPC Executive Committee member, Christine Paige, and will include presentations, panel discussions, a wildlife photo contest with prizes, informal lunch and social opportunities, and post-event field shoots.

We are developing a group of partners, commercial sponsors, and public grants to keep the cost of the event far below what is typical for photography educational programs of this quality.
