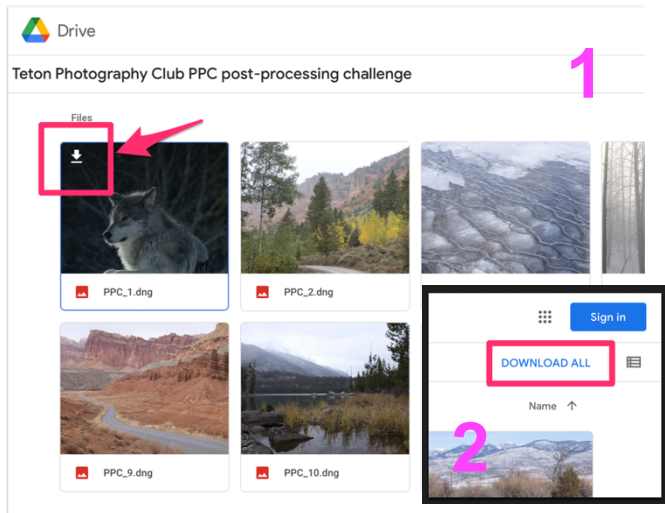


HOW TO DOWNLOAD IMAGES FROM GOOGLE DRIVE AND IMPORT THEM INTO LIGHTROOM. A step-by-step guide.



1) Go to the Google Drive at <https://tinyurl.com/58f7hehe> You should see previews of 10 images (image 1)

2) Hover your mouse over an image to see the downward facing arrow (see image labeled 1)

2a) OR go to top right and select "DOWNLOAD ALL" (image 2)

3) Click the arrow to begin downloading the image(s) (they will probably go to your "downloads" folder on your hard drive unless you have changed this setting).

4) Launch Lightroom Classic

7) Select the "file" menu (image 3)

8) Scroll to "import photos and videos" (image 3)

8a) OR select the import button from bottom left (image 4)

9) Locate the place where the photos downloaded to (check your "downloads" folder as this is the default for most browsers)

10) Select "import"

11) The image(s) will appear in your lightroom catalogue

11) Happy editing!

12) Please rename your files prior to upload in the following format, your initials, file ID, for example, JC_001, JC_002 etc

13) When you are done, upload your post-processed image(s) to the dedicated Dropbox folder named "WDID" located here. <https://tinyurl.com/2p9ak26c>
