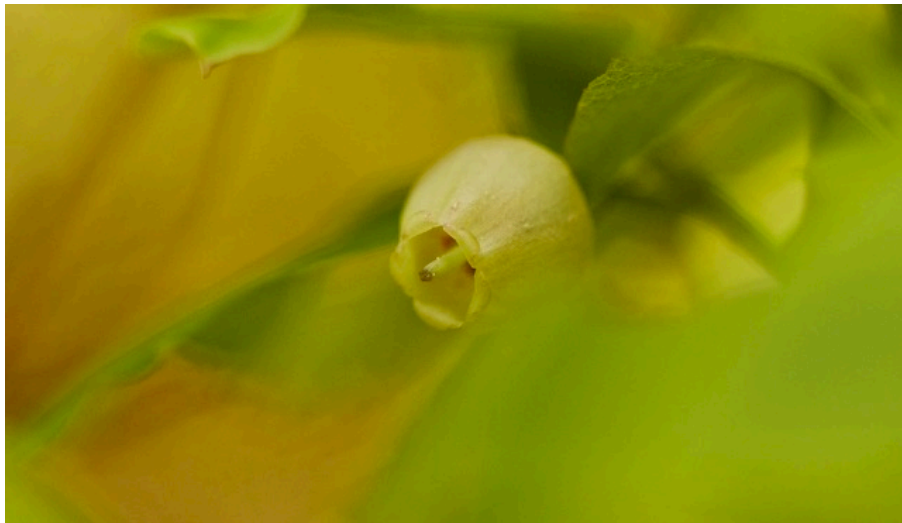
Happenings

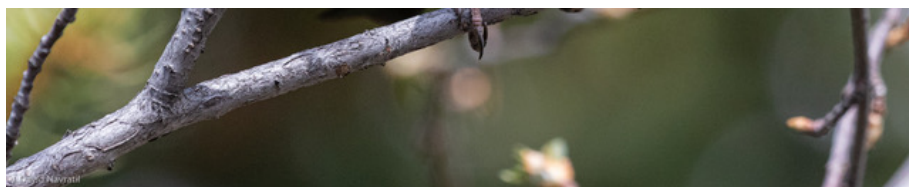

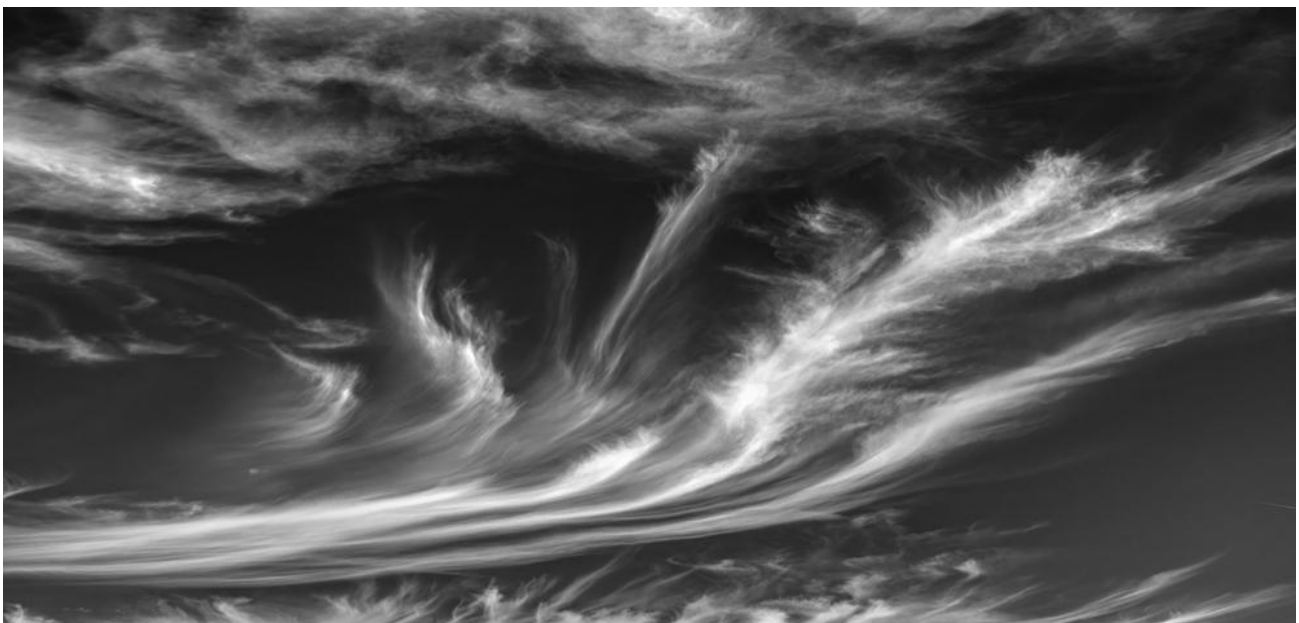
