Hedrick Pond Overlook and the Teton Valley, Saturday July 23, 2022

This magnificent view of the Teton Range and the valley below is one of the best kept secrets in town. We are unlikely to find any tourists shooting from this vantage point in the National Forest, and if the weather gods cooperate, we could get some wonderful sunset images.

Where: Our meeting point will be at the **Snake River Overlook** off highway 191 and we will carpool from that point. If you are familiar with our destination please do not attempt to drive up alone – the Lost Creek Ranch uses the area nearby for its campouts and has closed off the last part of the access road to keep others from entering. This leaves barely sufficient parking space for a couple of vehicles at the point where we will unload and begin the short hike to the overlook.

When: Saturday, July 23 at 6.30 pm. Sunset is at 8.55pm, so even if the weather gods do not give us a glowing sunset, we will have plenty of time for shooting before the sun sets. We will be leaving the overlook at 7:00 so be on time.

Bring: In addition to your camera gear, feel free to bring any food and drinks that you might wish. We will shoot and schmooze until after the sun has set, before carpooling back down to the Snake River Overlook

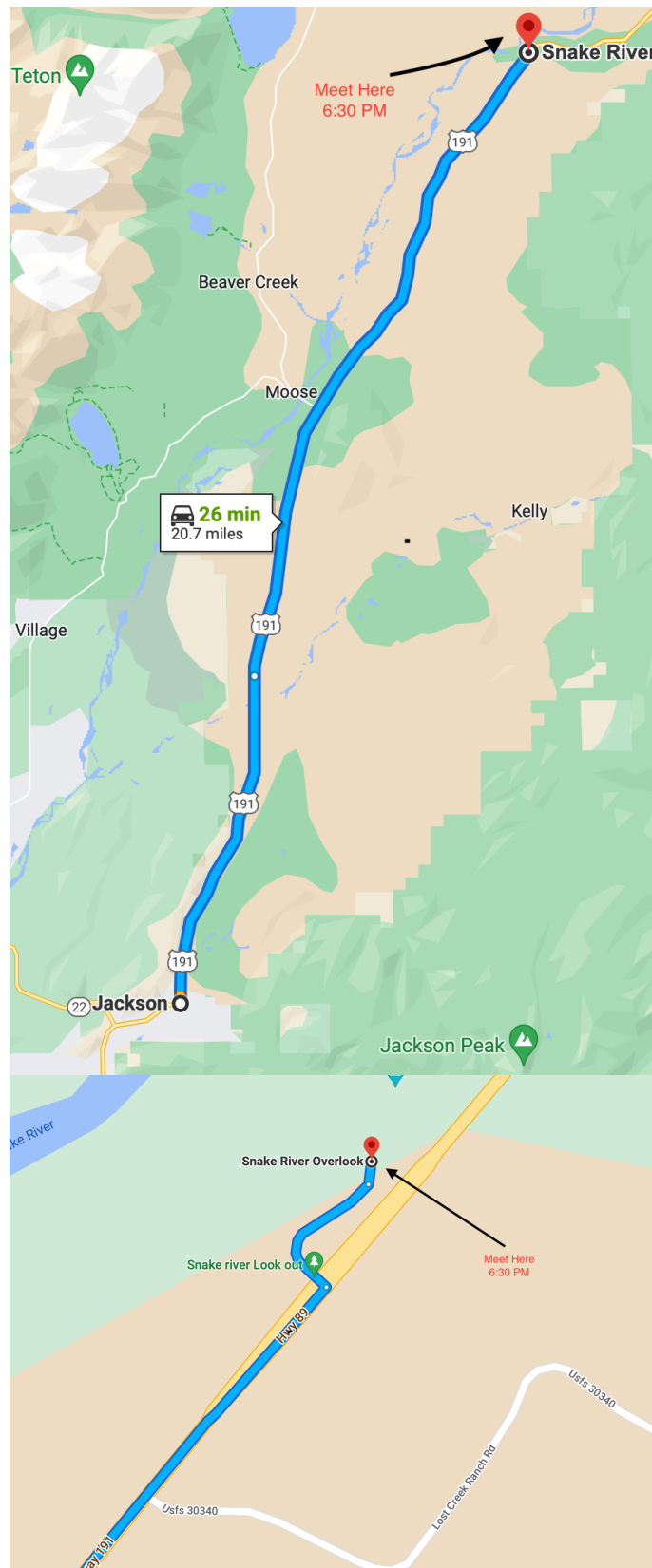
