Have you ever been sitting at your computer looking at a photo you've taken that you think is good, but you say to yourself, "What Do I Do with this photo?" What does it need? How do I make it better? Well, join the club. We all struggle with just how to make an image look like we know it should. Some even know the techniques but don't always know which techniques to apply. You're in luck. The TPC's WDID (What Do I Do?) is for you! During this Zoom and in person meeting, we'll look at out-of-the-camera RAW images from members. We will have a panel of skilled photo editors and, together with our members, offer suggestions as to how to make this good picture a great picture. Then, in real time, we'll use Lightroom to make adjustments and bring each photo to life!

You may submit one of your images, an unedited raw or .dng file, or just watch as we improve someone else's photo. It's a great learning session and lots of fun.

Here are the instructions:

Rename your file following this format.

Firstname_Lastname_anyname. (but keep your .dng or rawfile extension)

Once you have renamed your image, open the link:

Peer Mentor Program

The September 2022 Theme Challenge was Texture/Patterns. In October 2021 there was an extensive discussion of the Texture/Patterns Theme: It seemed that some peer mentors wanted the theme to focus on either texture or pattern and NOT a combination. So for the September 2022 Theme Challenge, Randy decided to have peer mentors submit photos identified as either a texture or pattern photo ... interesting 😊 or 😞

The first review was of the seven Pattern Photos. Most of the submissions received at least one vote and three photos stood out for the final vote. The 3rd place photo by Kathie was an insect on clearly patterned metal. The 2nd place photo by John was rattlesnakes where the skin was clearly a pattern. The winning photo by Charlotte was a salsify flower (goats beard) ready for the wind to lift its seeds.

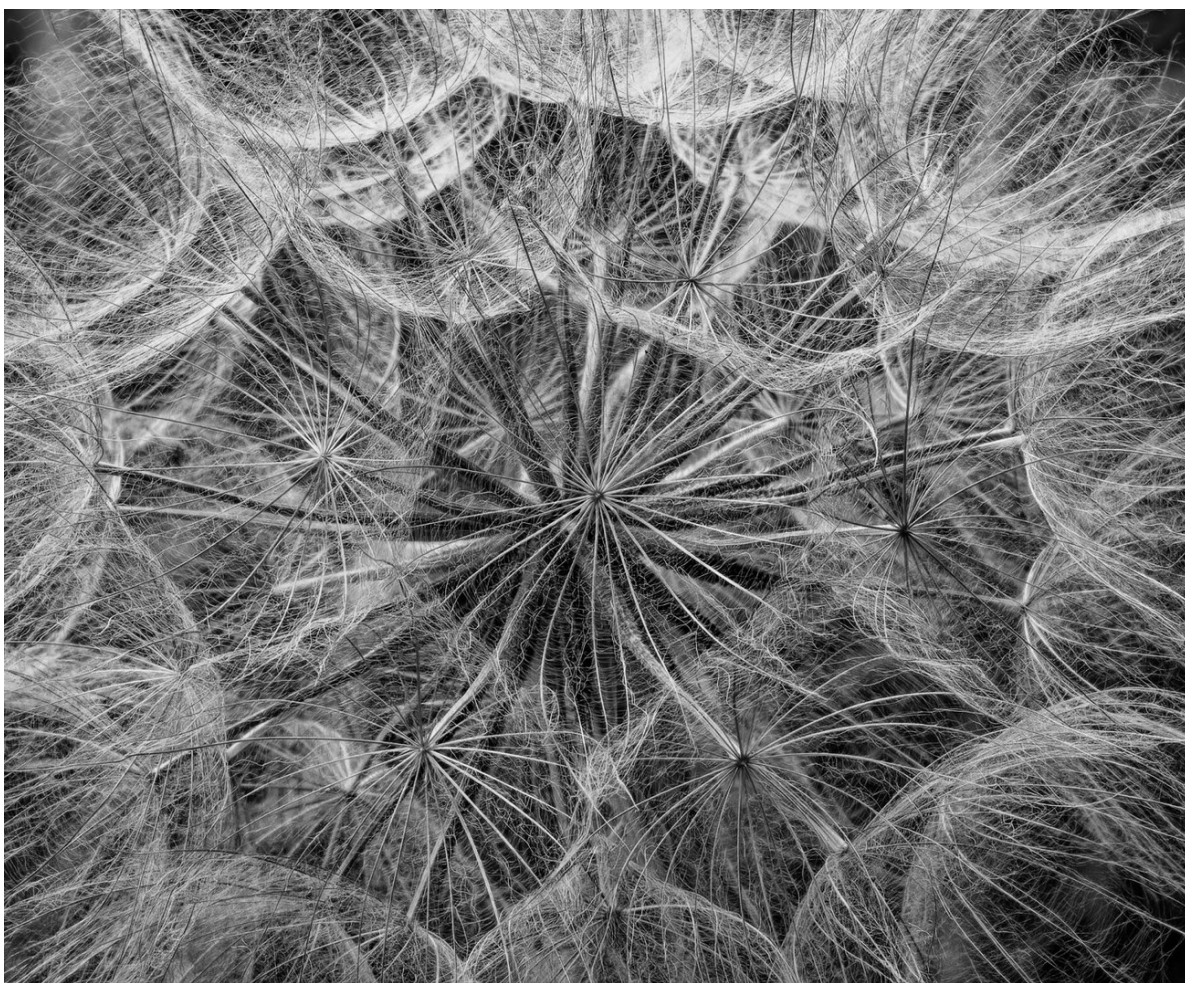
